Directions:

There are many ways to get to the site on various highways, your GPS may be the best guide.

Major routes:

From I-85/I-40: Take Hwy 421 south, take the Company Mill/Woody Mill exit (exit 194), turn left off ramp. At second light turn right on Liberty Rd, go approx 2 miles south on Liberty road and turn left on Dona Rd. Go approx 2 miles on Dona Rd and turn left onto Old Julian. Clarence Rd is on the left approx ½ mile. Look for Quicksilver Canine sign.

From south: Take Hwy 421 north, take Hwy 62 exit (exit 190), turn left off ramp, continue to first stop sign at Liberty Rd, turn right onto Liberty Rd, then take an immediate left onto Old Julian (there is a blinking light, if you pass the Gulf Station you went too far). Continue about 2 miles on Old Julian. Clarence Rd is on the left. Look for Quicksilver sign.

Clarence Rd is a gravel road, the training building is at the very end. You will pass thru the white fence, past some residences and farm buildings, continue to the end and you will see the facility, a blue metal building. Please adhere to the posted speed limit on the gravel road!

Site Information:

- Quicksilver Canine is a climate-controlled indoor facility with an 85 x 120 foot area with an artificial turf surface.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times while inside the building or in the warm-up area. Outside the building, dogs may be off leash as space allows. Owners are responsible for having their dogs under control at all times.
- Quicksilver Canine will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of Quicksilver Canine, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Any handler who is found to abuse a dog will be disqualified and reported to CPE.
- Anyone not currently in good standing with CPE will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- Quicksilver Canine has the right to refuse any entry for cause.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms.
- All competitors participate in the events at their own risk. The General Agreement must be signed in order to comply with CPE's acceptance and entrance to this trial
- You must clean up after your dog, if you don't, future entries will be refused.

General Information

The Trials will be held indoors. Trash cans and poop bags are located throughout the premises for your convenience in picking up after your dog(s).

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY: Any trained, healthy dog 15 months or older may compete in a CPE Agility Trial. All purebred and mixed-breeds are equally eligible for entry. Bitches in season or any dogs who are blind, lame or aggressive towards people or other animals are not eligible to compete.

FOOD: Coffee, tea, soft drinks, snacks, and lunch will be provided for all workers. If you have special dietary needs, there are several restaurants and a grocery store within 5 miles of Quicksilver.

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles may be used. Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements

POLICIES:

- Completed entries and fees must be received at the Trial Secretary's address no later than 6:00 p.m. on December 22nd. Day of Show Entries will be accepted if limits are not reached. There is no opening date. Entries that include an email address may be notified by email that the entry has been received. Overnighting entries has never really been necessary at our trials. If you still feel the need, please remember to waive the signature.
 - Refunds for pre-registered entries, will be given for bitches in season. Any additional withdrawals will be made on a case by case decision.
 - Moveups will be accepted through 6 pm on Monday, January 1, 2024.
 - Day-to-day moveups are permitted moveups must be made after the last class on Friday and Saturday. No moveups will be accepted in the morning.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of a Judge or the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, fire, civil disturbances, inclement weather, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the host club.
- Please follow the directions on the posted signs, pick up after your dog, and take time out to thank all of the volunteers for working so hard.

CPE trial rules – shortened version: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for registration info, "Registering with CPE" and further info on height categories and rules.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4" P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- ➤ Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- ➤ Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½" of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- > Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring. Effective January 1, 2022 handlers have a choice regarding dogs wearing collars. Dogs may run courses with or without one collar. Collars should be preferably quick release style, flat buckle, or rolled leather. No attachments of any kind are allowed on the collar. Flea and tick collars are permitted to be left on, but the dog may not wear an additional collar if this is worn. Dogs running with loose attachments on a collar are to be immediately NT'd and their run ended.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket the leash must be out of sight.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

For clubs that will allow Declared Training In the Ring

We (Host Club) will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items *are* considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- > Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

For Clubs that are not allowing Declared Training In the Ring:

We (host club) will not be offering Declared Training in the Ring at this trail. Please remember that the following is not considered Training in the ring:

- Dog grabbing it's leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

While running on course

- > The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.
